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
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

CVC SEECES

Phoneme segmentation is the process of breaking a word apart into its individual sounds. It is the opposite of blending sounds together to form a word. However, the two often go hand-in-hand. Phoneme segmentation helps build phonemic awareness and is one of the first steps in the reading process. Oftentimes, students have difficulty orally "stretching out" a word. I have found that using color coded CVC word cards help students identify the beginning, middle, and ending sounds; therefore, making it easier for students to segment each word. Being able to easily segment words is crucial for successful decoding, which is a major cornerstone in guided reading.

In this packet, you will find IIO CVC slider picture cards (32 short a, 18 short e, 22 short i, 18 short o, and 20 short u) and IIO CVC slider word cards with picture support (32 short a, 18 short e, 22 short i, 18 short o, and 20 short u), as well as 150 CVC slider cards without picture support (41 short a, 24 short e, 35 short i, 23 short o, and 27 short u).










CVC SEBERS

Use the cards alone (like the first picture), or with a CVC slider (like the second picture). Have the students touch the color coded dots and say the sound of each letter. Remind them that green is the beginning sound, yellow is the middle, and red is the ending sound. The color coded letters help with reading left to right. If you are using the CVC slider, the students will slide one bead for each phoneme. After sliding all three beads and saying all three phonemes, they will push the beads back and say the word. Use the word cards with pictures to provide extra support.







CVC SESCERS


You can make your CVC sliders using 20 mm wooden beads and shoelaces or using acrylic beads and pipe cleaners. I purchased both of the beads from Joann's Fabrics and spray painted the wooden beads.









































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
